Motel type, 3-star or 4-star Hotel

YES

A Motel is the natural choice of motorists and travellers with car

A Motel is usually positioned next to large roads (motorways or national roads), connecting large urban or tourist areas and having a large traffic of motors.

YES

A Motel has spaces for the reception, stay, dining and pleasure of clients, and bedrooms (at least 10) with private bathrooms and other auxiliary areas.

YES

Dining and pleasure areas of the Motel can also be used by transit clients.

A Motel has a large parking for cars (minimum one place per room), as well as parking for autobuses.

YES

A Motel has a shop for selling newspapers, magazines and tobacco products.

YES

Motels consist of one or more buildings or complexes, integrally formed in a single plot

YES

A Motel is allowed to have a Gas Station
