CSP is located in a mountain resort area

YES

Note: CSP = Certified Service Provider

According to Alfa-Cert definitions and evaluation criteria, the **Greek mountain resort areas** are Arachova, Delphi, Elati, Kalabaka and Meteora, Kaimakcalan, Kalavryta, Karpenisi, Metsovo, Pelion, Trikala of Corinthia, Vermio and 3-5 Pigadia in Imathia, Vasilitsa in Grevena, Vytina and Zagorochoria.

Agrafa, Chelmos, Dimitsana, Florina, Lagadia in Arcadia, Lailias in Serres, Mont Falakro in Drama, Mont Grammos,, Mont Parnitha, Mont Vitsi, Nypheon, Parnassida (in Mont Parnassos), Pertouli and Tzoumerka are under Alfa-Cert evaluation at present.

A mountain resort has a large number of hotels, rentals, restaurants, bars, night clubs, tourist attractions and amenities. Tourism is one of the main income sources of the mountain resort.

Even a mountain resort cannot be ideal in all areas. This specification demands that CSP covers also the following points:

CSP is relatively near (by car) to restaurants and cafes

CSP is relatively near (by car) to bars or night clubs

YES

CSP is relatively near (by car) to a Super-Market or Mini-Market

YES

CSP is relatively near (by car) to a shopping area

YES

CSP is relatively near (by car) to a ski center and/or near to an area characterized as "national forest"

CSP is relatively near (by car) to a Pharmacy or Doctor's office or Health Center or Hospital

There are no sources of noise, bad smell or ugly looking, such as factories, warehouses etc, near CSP's facilities
